IN THE FIFTH GRADE CLASSROOM

Our teachers are working in the classrooms to build their students' knowledge and skills in all content areas.

All subjects are taught through explicit instruction to ensure that students are learning the required academic standards to mastery. Additional supports are given to students who need remediation and or acceleration. Some examples of what students are working on are multiplying and dividing fractions in math, interpreting meaning from text in reading, and writing in various genres.

Students also have access to the computer lab and classrooms are equipped with state of the art technology for 21st century learning.



SUDER STUDENTS

Lillie E. Suder Elementary School students have shared ownership of their learning. Below are some of the responses that our fifth grade students shared about their learning:

- ◆ I will dedicate 30 minutes daily to reading on-level AR books.
- ◆ I will log into Study Island at least 5 times weekly at home.
- ◆ I will make sure I have mastered math facts in order to excel in higher level multiplication and division problems.

AT HOME

Lillie E. Suder Elementary School families joined staff to bridge the academic gap between the classroom and home in an effort to increase student success in Reading and Math.

- ◆ Access provided websites to support and challenge child's academics.
- ◆ Provide real world examples of how skills such as decimals, fractions, multiplication, and division are used in everyday life.
- ◆ Use suggested household items to create manipulatives at home to reinforce their academic needs.
